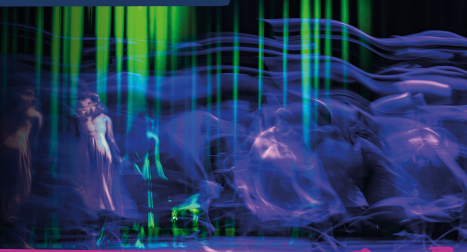

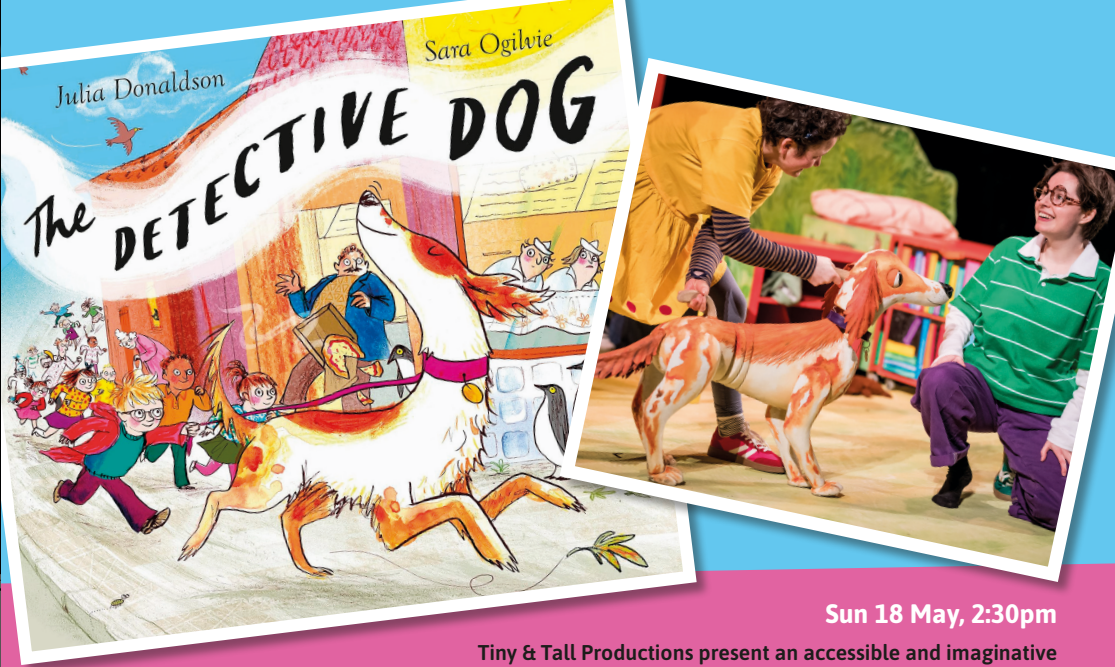
MONUMENT TO CHILDHOOD

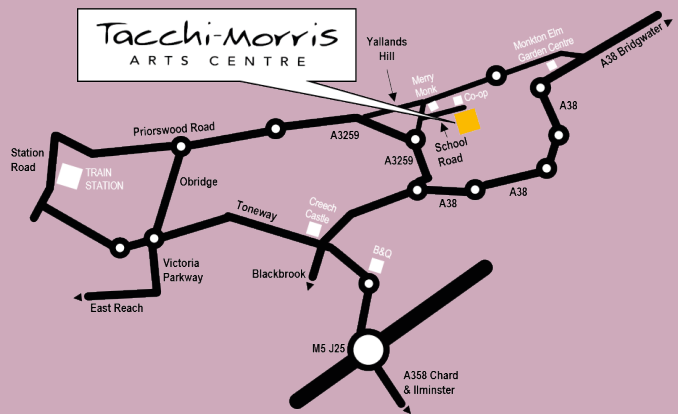

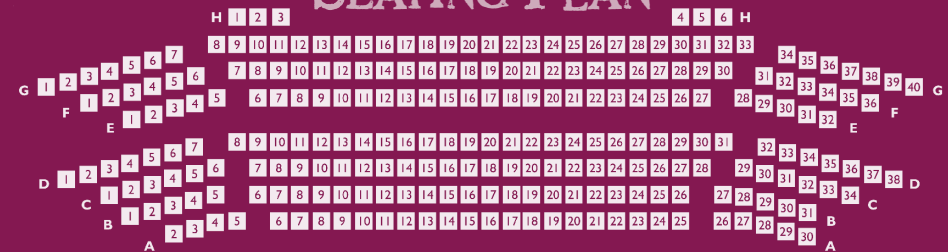
